# RULES & AGENDA



Thank you for your interest in the first ever CACHE DAYS! Cache Days is a three-day seeded hunt, where we have gone out to a predetermined location and buried caches for the participants to find. This hunt is open to the public. On the day of the hunt (Saturday) each participant will be given a packet of information. This information will contain clues that if put together correctly would give the whereabouts of each cache location. Below is a list of rules as well as an agenda for the weekend.

## RULES:

1. Entrants must provide their own metal detector, accessories and target recovery tools.
2. No search coils larger than twelve inches are allowed. NOTE: No oversized coils of any kind will be allowed.
3. No pulse induction (PI) metal detectors allowed.
4. Each participant must register prior to the hunt start.
5. No person shall hunt, detect, dig prior to hunt start. Except in designated locations.
6. No person will hunt outside of the designated time frames.
7. All finds must be removed and either stored or trashed post hunt.
8. All holes must be filled.
9. No property damage of any kind will be tolerated.
10. If you locate a cache, you must remove it, fill your hole and report back to a hunt coordinator.
  - a. Locating a cache removes you from the hunt.
  - b. You cannot put the cache "back" and continue to hunt.
  - c. You cannot share any information with any other participant on your way off the field.
11. If you violate any of these rules or act in a manner that a hunt coordinator deems unbecoming of the ethics of the sport or disrespectful to other participants, you will be removed from the competition and any cache found will be returned.
